PrimaTimber Oy was established in 2003, and it proudly continues in the footsteps of livari Mononen, specialising in building and impregnated timber.

At PrimaTimber, we want to cherish the roots of the company. The timber we use as our raw material comes from sustainably managed northern forests. 












What is impregnated timber and what are its benefits?

Outdoors, timber can easily become blue-stained, mouldy or rotten. Research shows that pressure impregnation is the most efficient way to protect timber and extend its lifecycle even in demanding applications. PrimaTimber's impregnated timber is treated according to the Nordic Wood Preservation Council's NTR certification requirements, up to the heartwood. The NTR-certified production method has been approved by an external independent quality assurance system, and it guarantees an extended lifecycle for the timber, up to four times longer than that of untreated timber. The use of impregnated timber reduces the consumption of forest resources, transports and the resources required for continuous repairs.

There are two treatment categories:



NTR A: Products in possible contact with the ground (48 mm and thicker)




NTR AB: Products used for structures above the ground

All our timber treatment substances have been approved by the safety authorities.

Impregnated up to the heartwood

The NTR-certified production method guarantees that the timber is impregnated up to the heartwood. This gives the timber optimal protection against weather conditions.



Colour options

The basic colours for impregnated timber are brown and green. In addition, we produce grey, industrially treated timber.

PrimaTimbers timber products are made from Finnish wood from sustainably managed and PEFC certified forests.

Our products bind 12 times more carbon than their production produces fossil emissions. Compared to the competing materials, the carbon footprint of our products is small.


Our group uses the international ISO 9001 quality system and the ISO 14001 environmental system.

Planed planks, boards and battens

Build a comfortable and elegant terrace, deck or fence with PrimaTimber's planed boards, planks and battens. In addition to smooth planed products, we offer different profiles for an attractive look and feel. For example, grooved surfaces are not so slippery and make a safe choice for decks.

If you are looking for additional sturdiness and durability for your deck, choose thicker and wider planed plank. Planed products give an attractive look to various outdoor constructions and fences.

We also offer a wide range of battens that can be used for decorative purposes.

Sawn boards and battens

PrimaTimber's sawn boards and battens are excellent for fences and trellises, especially if you plan to paint them because paint adheres well on rough surfaces. Please remember that if you paint the products, make sure they are dry first!

Sawn wood is also a good choice for decks that do not need a sleek and finished look. Sawn wood is practical and safe thanks to its rough surface that is not slippery when wet. We recommend thick sawn boards for dock decking.

Frame materials

A carefully built frame is the key for long lasting, safe, and beautiful decks and stairs. Rough planed planks, beams and gluelam beams are ideal for building a strong foundation.


Often, frame structures do not need to be planed on the surface. However, if you prefer a more finished surface material, the rough planed plank is your choice. It is affordable and easy to process. In case your deck is large and you require longer than regular lengths, finger jointed materials are a good choice.

If your deck requires a smart final touch, use planed, gluelam timber. Gluelam posts, for example, make excellent and strong railing posts. Gluelam products are produced from laminated timber that are glued together. This ensures less natural movement of timber.

Refined spruce timber


High-quality spruce is naturally straight-grained. PrimaTimber's rough planed and visually strength graded spruce planks are used, for example, for frame construction in buildings. In addition, we offer rough planed battens of different sizes. Spruce is a lightweight wood that is easy to work with.

All of our strength graded spruce products have the CE marking. Our selection includes the most common sizes in a wide range of lengths. The spruce products are visually graded to strength grade C24 according to the EN 338, which is the most common grade used in construction.
